WEATHER

December weather in Cairo: This is one of the more attractive times of the year to visit the city. The average daily temperature during this month in Cairo is 15°C (59°F). This can reach highs of

20°C (68°F) or drop to lows of 10°C (50°F).

Cairo sees an average of 5 mm over 4 days of rain during this month.

Cairo experiences, on average, 8 hours of sunshine per day at this time of the year.

INTERNET

Internet will be available in the official hotel for free (in hotel rooms, in the lobby and during the Congress).

CURRENCY

Today's exchange rate in Egypt is **1 USD = 48.5 Egyptian Pounds (EGP)** – Official for 15/09/2024. Currency exchange is only allowed at the Banks, Hotels and Exchange offices.

ELECTRICITY

Egypt has a 220V / 50Hz electrical system, with two plug types: Plug type C and plug type F. Plug type C has two round pins, while plug type F has two round pins and two earth clips on the side.

ABOUT THE CITY

Cairo is the capital of Egypt and the Cairo Governorate, and is the Egypt's largest city, being home to more than 10 million people. It is also part of the largest urban agglomeration in Africa, the Arab World and the Middle East. The Greater Cairo metropolitan area is the 12th-largest in the world by population with over 22.1 million people.

Cairo is associated with ancient Egypt, as the Giza pyramid complex and the ancient cities of Memphis and Heliopolis are located in its geographical area. Located near the Nile Delta, the city first developed as Fustat following the Muslim conquest of Egypt in 641 next to an existing ancient Roman fortress, Babylon. Cairo was founded by the Fatimid dynasty in 969. It later superseded Fustat as the main urban centre during the Ayyubid and Mamluk periods (12th–16th centuries). Cairo has long been a centre of the region's political and cultural life, and is titled "the city of a thousand minarets" for its preponderance of Islamic architecture. Cairo's historic center was awarded World Heritage Site status in 1979.

Cairo has the oldest and largest film and music industry in the Arab world, as well as Egypt's oldest institution of higher learning, Al-Azhar University. Many international media, businesses, and organizations have regional headquarters in the city; the Arab League has had its headquarters in Cairo for most of its existence.
